5. Please give brief details of any previous boat handling or sailing experience. Specify any time spent as Master if any.
6. All crew applicants must declare their fitness to be a crew member. If "YES" is answered to any question then NWT may require further information or require a medical assessment before accepting onto the Approved Crew list. Applicants for the position of Skipper will be required to undertake a MCA Seafarers ML5 medical examination by a Doctor.
7. Before an applicant can be added to the Approved Crew list they will be invited to attend a one day session to assess their suitability to undertake the physical tasks involved in the normal operation of Albion.
